



## Albert Joseph Randolph

July 6, 1920 - February 15, 2006

Albert J. Randolph age 85 of Harbor Beach passed away unexpectedly at his home following an apparent heart attack.

Born in Atina, Italy on July 6, 1920, he was the son of the late Dominic and Aretta (Marini) Randolph. Al became a U.S. Citizen in 1936.

On August 10, 1946, Al and Gloria Pompei were united in marriage in Detroit, Michigan.

Together they owned and operated the Randolph Family Restaurant in Harbor Beach from 1982 until they retired in 2004.

Al was a veteran of World War II serving in Hawaii and Okinawa in the US Army.

He was a former member and president of the Harbor Beach Lions Club, a member of the VFW Post in Harbor Beach and past Commander and active member of the American Legion Post 197 of Harbor Beach, a member of Our Lady of Lake Huron Catholic Church in Harbor Beach and attended the Community Coffee Club and enjoyed playing cards.

Surviving are his wife Gloria Randolph of Harbor Beach and 2 sons: Dennis Randolph and his wife Renada of Battle Creek and David Randolph of Harbor

Beach. 5 grandchildren: Paul, Steven, Scott, Kevin and Savannah. Two sisters also survive: Sylvia Swiecki of Wyandotte and Phillis Iacono of Almont.

Al was preceded in death by a daughter Sharon.

Funeral mass for Al Randolph will be Saturday , Feb. 18, 2006 at 11am in Our Lady of Lake Huron Catholic Church, Harbor Beach with burial in the Church Cemetery with military honors by the American Legion and VFW. A parish vigil service will be Friday at 730 pm in the Ramsey Funeral Home, Harbor Beach where visitation will be on Thursday from 7-9pm, Friday from 1-5 & 7-9pm and Saturday at the church from 10am until the time of services.
