ALLEN JAMES ARNDT, age 82 of Harbor Beach, passed away Monday, June 27, 2016 at Lakeview Extended Care and Rehab Center of the Harbor Beach Community Hospital.

He was born on April 4, 1934, in Harbor Beach to the late Carl and Ella (Rupp) Arndt. He was baptized in Trinity Lutheran Church in Forestville. Allen grew up on the family farm, he sailed the great lakes for 3 seasons, just out of high school, before being drafted into the US Army from 1957 to 1959, as a mechanic. He and Marjorie Edwards were united in marriage on April 25, 1959. Together they purchased the dairy farm together.

Allen enjoyed giving bear hugs, tractor rides with his John Deere AR through the woods, watching ships pass under the Blue Water Bridge in Port Huron, going for afternoon rides to look at crops, getting ice cream cones, and his wife's homemade apple pies and bread.
