ANDREW T. SCHULTE, age 48 of Port Hope, passed away Friday, March 11, 2016.

He was born on July 17, 1967 in Harbor Beach, the son of Margaret (Leese) Schulte and the late Joseph Schulte. Andy and Wendy Koglin were united in marriage on September 3, 1994 in St. Mary's in Kinde. He worked as an operator and Gemini Plastics in Ubly. 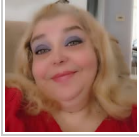
