Annabell Seidl, age 98 of Ruth, passed away Monday, March 25, 2024 at United

Hospice, Marlette Hospital.

Annabell was born on October 25, 1925 on the family farm in Delaware Township, Sanilac County, daughter of the late George and Matilda (Block) Artman.

On January 17, 1949 she was united in marriage to Leo J. Seidl. He preceded her in death in 2008.
