Arthur J. Wilkowski age 88 of Deckerville formerly of Port Hope passed away Tuesday, April 19, 2005 in Autumnwood of Deckerville.

Born in Detroit, MI on July 27, 1916, Art was the son of the late Frank and Agnes (Abraham) Wilkowski.

Art was a veteran of World War II serving in the US Army serving in the European, African and Middle Eastern Theaters.
