AUGUST C. `BOB` MASCHKE, beloved husband, father and grandfather, went to be with the Lord Thursday, January 10, 2008 at Lakeview Extended Care and Rehab Center of Harbor Beach Community Hospital. Bob was 90 years old and lived in Port hope.

Bob was born on March 31, 1917 in Port Hope to the late August R. and Minnie (Berndt) Maschke. He and Evelyn Schave were united in marriage on December 1, 1945 in Port Hope, She preceded him in death on February 4, 2005.

Bob was a veteran of World War II serving in the US Army in the Western Pacific, Phillippines, New Guinea and other pacific theatre. He is a retired employee of Hercules Inc., retiring in 1979 after working 23 years, He was a member of the St. John Lutheran Church of Port Hope, where he was a Sunday School Superintendant for many years, on the board of trustees, a member of the AmVets Post of Port Hope and past commander, a 60 year member of the American Legion Post 197 of Harbor Beach, a former Boy Scout Leader, Port Hope Firefighter, and past president of the Port Hope Retirees.
