



## Cpl. Curtis James Wells

March 14, 1931 - August 31, 2016

Cpl. CURTIS JAMES WELLS, age 19, of Harbor Beach, was Missing-In-Action, from North Korea, on November 27, 1950, and was declared dead by the US Army on March 18, 1954. His remains were repatriated and recovered in the fall of 1998, and were recently identified as those of being Cpl. Wells. He was born on March 14, 1931, in Uby, to the late Wilbert & Emma (Sutton) Wells.

He attended Harbor Beach Community Schools, and he enjoyed working and riding with horses.

Cpl. Wells is survived by brother: William Wells and his wife Judy of Harbor Beach, H. Dale Wells and his wife Lucille of Lake Odessa, and sister: Betty Liedke and her husband Robert of Bad Axe.

His remains will be flown from Hawaii to Detroit Metropolitan Airport on Tuesday, September 6, 2016, and transported to the Ramsey Funeral Home of Harbor Beach.

Full Military Graveside Services will be conducted by the US Army, on Saturday, September 10, 2016 at 1 pm, at Rock Falls Cemetery of Harbor Beach. Arrangements are being handled by the Ramsey Funeral Home of Harbor Beach.
