July 28, 1931 - June 9, 2003

David E. Dickinson age 71 of Harbor Beach passed away Monday, June 9, 2003 in Brian`s House of Essexville following a brief illness. Born in Harbor Beach on July 28, 1931, he was the son of Beatrice (Ganley) Dickinson and the late Earl Dickinson. Dave was a veteran of the Korean Conflict serving in the U.S. Navy.
