July 26, 1925 - August 31, 2007

Delbert F. Emerick age 82 of Port Hope passed away Friday, August 31, 2007 in the Lakeveiw Extended Care and Rehab Center of the Harbor Beach Community Hospital.

Born in Port Hope on July 26, 1925, Del was the son of the late Stanley and Bessie (Hagerty) Emerick.
