Earl Leo Booms, 87, of Harbor Beach passed away on Sunday, January 3, 2021 at McLaren Thumb Region Hospital after a short illness.

Later, he watched the Detroit Tigers and Detroit Lions games on TV, his favorite phrase being “Good Gravy” when a bad play was made. He loved to play Euchre and enjoyed socializing with family, friends and anyone that had a few minutes to spare.
