EDWARD BARNEY SCHUBRING, age 79 of Port Hope, passed away, April 1, 2009 at St. Mary's of Michigan in Saginaw, Michiga.

He was born on September 2, 1929 in Port Hope to the late Edward and Martha (Zick) Schubring. Barney and Annabelle Thrusman were united in marriage on December 6, 1952 in Port Hope.
