November 14, 1926 - December 30, 2016

Edward J. Gehring Sr., 90, of Harbor Beach, MI passed away peacefully at his home on Friday, December 30, 2016 surrounded by family. Edward was born on November 14, 1926 in Harbor Beach, MI, the son of the late John and Edith (Zmich) Gehring. Edward and Marianne Shaltry were united in marriage on April 4, 1959 at St. Anthony of Padua Retreat House in Saginaw, MI.

Together with his wife Marianne and family, Edward owned and operated Rock Falls Farm just south of Harbor Beach on M-25 where Edward raised Registered Belgian Horses and Registered Holstein Cattle.

Edward was a lifelong member of Our Lady of Lake Huron (Holy Name of Mary Parish) Catholic Church and attended Our Lady of Lake Huron Catholic School.

Edward served as a Corporal in the United States Marine Corp, 4th Division during WWII in the Pacific Theatre. Upon returning from the war Edward was instrumental in organizing the Harbor Beach VFW Post #9344 and served as a Charter Member. He was a member of the "WWII Fighting Fourth" Marine Organization which had its final muster in August of 2015.

Edward served his community as a Sand Beach Township Board Member, Huron County Soil Conservation/ASCS Committee member, Michigan Milk Producers Advisory Board and Member Delegate, Huron Community Fair Board, Huron County DHIA Board, Huron County Holstein Association Board, Belgian Draft Horse Corporation of America, and he was the Charter President of the Thumb Draft Horse Association.

Edward's hobbies and interests were many and varied. He enjoyed Antique Cast Iron Farm Seat Collecting, Golden Bantam Chickens, Flemish Blue Giant Rabbits, Draft Horse Shows, Dairy and Beef Cattle Shows, was supportive of 4-H and FFA events, vegetable gardening, but most of all he enjoyed his two favorite passions of fine and detailed woodworking in his woodshop, and the sight and sound of his Purple Martins.

He loved visiting with family, friends and neighbors, and especially his grandchildren.
