ELIZABETH ANN BOWEN, age 89 of Grand Rapids, formerly of Harbor Beach, passed away Tuesday, November 29, 2016 at her home under hospice care.

She was born on December 8, 1926 in Flint, to the late Edward and Elizabeth (Bassingthwaight) Clifford. Beth and Harvey Bowen were united in marriage on January 1, 1949 in Wellston, Michigan. He preceded her in death on March 10, 2005.

Beth was a graduate of Michigan State College in 1948 with a B.S. in Medical Technology. She worked as a med tech at Harbor Beach Community Hospital for 21 years, and also worked at Sparrow Hospital, in Lansing, and Detroit Memorial Hospital in Detroit. She is survived by her children: David Bowen of Lakeville, MN, and Phillip and his wife Cathryn Bowen of Grand Rapids, and 2 grandchildren: Patrick (Aleaha) and Andrew (Lisa), 3 great grandsons, and her brother John Clifford and his wife Martha Baker of St. Louis, Missouri.
