Emmett Arthur Trudeau, age 79, passed away at home on Thursday, January 16th, 2025. He was born in Detroit on December 16th, 1945 to the late Leonard and Mary Jo Trudeau. He was the only son along with 4 sisters. There were always stories about him being the “wild boy” growing up and he would say that he always got blamed for everything! After high school he enlisted in the United States Navy and served for 6 years. After his service, he went on to work for Ford Motor Company as an Electrician. 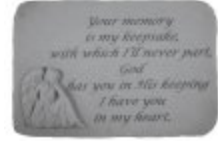
