



## Frances Rita Mausolf

March 3, 1924 - January 16, 2015

Frances Rita (LaMielle) Mausolf, 90, of Harbor Beach, went to be with her Lord and Savior surrounded by family on Friday, January 16, 2015 at Courtney Manor where she resided for the past six years.
