Francis R. Schulte, age 88 of Port Hope, passed away Tuesday, April 4, 2023 at Ascension Providence Rochester Hospital.

He was born on March 1, 1935 in Harbor Beach to the late Edward and Catherine (Kramer) Schulte. Fran and Nona LeBouf were united in marriage on August 20, 1960. She preceded him in death on April 4, 2018. Fran worked in Production at Tower Automotive for 29 years. He served in the US Air Force from 1956-1959.

Fran was a member of Our Lady of Lake Huron Catholic Church, a life member of the AmVets Post 115 of Port Hope, the Knights of Columbus of Harbor Beach, the Port Hope Retirees, and the Grindstone, Port Hope Sportsmans Club.
