Frank G. Smith age 75 of Port Hope passed away Saturday, June 7, 2008 at his home in Port Hope with his family at his side.

Born in Albion, MI on July 3, 1932, Frank was the son of the late C. Reginald and Ethel (Dean) Smith.

Frank was a graduate of Michigan State University and attended Albion College and was a veteran of the Korean Conflict serving in the US Army.

On September 17, 1960, Frank and Ethel Hall were united in marriage in Huron City. Ethel preceded him in death on January 27, 1998.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church in Port Hope, a volunteer for the Port Hope Fire Department for over 45 years, and an active member of the Harbor Beach Rotary Club and a Paul Harris Fellow. Frank was a farmer spending his life on the family Sesquicentennials Farm outside of Port Hope where the farm originated in 1851, Frank also enjoyed doing craft projects and hunting.
