



## Fred K. Muter

July 10, 1935 - June 13, 2015

Fred K. Muter, age 79, of Port Hope, passed Saturday, June 13, 2015 at Covenant Medical Center of Saginaw.

He was born on July 10, 1935 in Port Hope to the late John and Helen (Weiss) Muter. Fred and Joann Finkel were united in marriage on September 29, 1956 in Port Hope. Fred worked at the Huron County Road Commission for 33 years, retiring in 1997. He was a member of St. John Lutheran Church of Port Hope, the Grindstone Port Hope Sportsmen's Club, and the Port Hope Retirees. Fred enjoyed getting coffee every morning with all his friends at the Gas Station. He enjoyed hunting, Deer Camp, cutting wood, tractors, being at the barn, and being with his grandchildren.
