HARRY J. SIEMEN, age 86 of Harbor Beach, passed away Monday, March 2, 2015, at Covenant Medical Center of Saginaw.

He was born on April 4, 1928, in Harbor Beach to the late Anthony and Mary (Gusa) Siemen. Harry Served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. He and Patsy Wohlford were united in marriage on June 11, 1955, at Our Lady of Lake Huron Catholic Church of Harbor Beach. Harry was employed at Booms Construction both in building construction and masonry/brickwork, then later retired from Pigeon Co-op in 1991. In retirement, Harry and Patsy enjoyed their winter home in Florida for more than 18 years.

Harry took pride in his gardening, especially his vegetables, and loved sharing them with family, friends and neighbors. He had a great memory and could remember anybody's birthday. 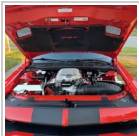
