Henry T. Weber, age 79 of Grand Rapids, passed away December 14, 2008 in the Veterans Home of Grand Rapids.

He was born on January 16, 1929 in Harbor Beach, Michigan. He married Deanna Krimsevig and resided in Huber Heights, Ohio, Westerville, Ohio and West Bloomfield. Upon his divorce, he resided in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, Port St. Lucie, Florida, Chesaning, and at the Veterans Home in Grand Rapids.

Henry served in the Navy from 1951 to 1954 on the USS Chivo, where he received a Navy Occupation Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal and a Good Conduct Medal. He attended Dayton University where he received his bachelor degree in Marketing. He was employed as a captain for the Great Lakes Steamship Company; was the plant manager for Burdett Oxygen of Detroit; and was the owner of Beeline Oxygen in West Palm Beach, Florida, and AA Pools of Lake Park, Florida. Henry loved polkas, fishing and was an avid golfer-even working for the PGA of Port St. Lucie, Florida as a tee master and ranger during his retirement years.

He is survived by four children; two siblings; Martha Crofcheck of Troy and Paul Weber of Mount Clemens, and four grandchildren.
