IDA L. BUCHOLTZ age 89 of Port Hope passed away Thursday, November 13, 2003 in the long term care unit of the Harbor Beach Community Hospital. Born in Port Hope on December 23, 1913, she was the daughter of the late William and Mahale (Rothwell) McKim. On October 27, 1930, Ida and William Bucholtz were united in marriage in Toledo, Ohio. Together they operated the IGA Store and Locker Plant in Port Hope, the 4 Corners Hardware in Lewisville along with the dealerships of Minneapolis-Molene Tractors and Studebaker Cars. William preceded her in death on June 18, 1992. Ida was a member of St. John Lutheran church in Port Hope and was a member of the Ladies Aid, Ladies Auxiliary, and the Sewing Circle. She also was a member of the Port Hope Retirees Club. She is survived by her children: William Bucholtz of FL, Karen Lemanski of Port Hope, Connie Wilkowski and her husband Dennis of Port Hope, and Gerald Bucholtz and his wife Mary Ann of Port Hope. 18 grandchildren and 35 great grandchildren.
