Jim was born on March 30, 1951 in Harbor Beach. He was the son of the late Earl J. and Frances Rita (LaMielle) Mausolf.

James and Linda Groth were united in marriage on September 16, 1978 at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Ruth.

He served in the US Army during the Viet Nam War from 1971 to 1973

James farmed all his life, milking cows and raising beef cattle. He was a parishioner of St. Anthony's Church of Holy Name of Mary Parish in Helena, a member of the Helena Farm Bureau and the Ruth Council of the Knights of Columbus.
