JEROME F. MEYER, age 88 of Sterling Heights, formerly of Harbor Beach, passed away Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at Troy Beaumont Hospital, surrounded by his daughters.

He was born on November 9, 1928 in Harbor Beach to the late Charles and Victoria (Blavis) Meyer. He and Vincenta Schubring were united in marriage on October 6, 1951 in Harbor Beach. She preceded him in death on August 1, 1997. Jerome served in the US Navy, and was a member of the American Legion Post 197.
