JEROME BERNARD VOLMERING, age 77, passed away on February 2, 2015 at Lakeview Extended Care and Rehab Center in Harbor Beach, with his loving family by his side under hospice care. He fought a long courageous battle against leukemia.

Jerome was born on January 12, 1938 in Sherman Township to the late William and Anna (Emming) Volmering. He attended Sts. Peter and Paul School in Ruth. He joined the US Navy in November of 1955 and served two years. After his service in the military, he farmed all his life and loved farm work and his animals.
