JOEL J. WEBER, age 82 of Ruth, passed away Saturday, July 4, 2020 at his home under hospice care, with his family by his side.

He was born on July 16, 1937 in Harbor Beach to the late Charles and Martha (Whipping) Weber. Joel served in the US Army from 1958-1959. He and Sharlyn Trepkoski were married on November 25, 1961.

Joel displayed a lifelong dedication to farming the land that he loved. He was a skilled finish carpenter, mastering the art of bowl turning using a lathe and created many magnificent pieces of art. He was a member of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church, where he was a long time usher, he was a member of the Ruth Knights of Columbus, and the Two Cylinder Club. He meticulously restored antique John Deere Tractors and Model A Cars. Joel enjoyed his long service on the Huron County Planning Commission, he was an avid reader, and served as a Sherman Township Trustee. He and Sharlyn enjoyed travelling and visiting all 50 states and many cruise ship destinations.

Joel is survived by his wife Sharlyn Weber of Ruth, children: Craig (Becky) Weber, Karen (Christopher) Sweet and Jill (Scott) Kociba; 8 grandchildren: Matthew, Nicole, Kendra, Mitch, Adam, Audrey, Rachel and Clara, and a sister Wilma Braun.

Funeral Mass for Joel will be Wednesday, July 8, 2020 at 11 am, at Staints Peter and Paul Catholic Church of Ruth, of the Holy Apostles Parish, with Fr. Matt Federico officiating.
