Kelly Colin Gainor, age 80 of Harbor Beach, passed away Saturday, August 10, 2024 peacefully at Lakeview Extended Care of Harbor Beach, after a short battle with cancer.

Kelly was the first born to Annabel and Colin Gainor, while his father was with the US Army during, World War II.

Kelly was a 1962 graduate of Harbor Beach Community Schools. After Graduation, he attended barber school in Detroit. He worked for many summers at the Guard House at the Harbor Beach Resort Association. He also was a transporter for Department of Human Services, providing transportation for those in need of medical appointments, errands, etc. Kelly's "Gift of Gab" made their journey enjoyable.

Kelly was a self taught, by ear, accordion player, which he played upside down. He was one of the original "Cattail Bay Muskrats" along with his father Colin (tenor banjo), Dr. Stewart Young, Warren Ramsey, Dr. Earnshaw (Doc), Dr. Manual Teves, his wife Pat, James Hunter, and Dick Roberts.

Kelly's love for polka music and performing continued and he enjoyed playing at the Harbor Beach Visitor Center, The Murphy Museum during the Farmer's Market, and for the residents of Lakeview Extended Care and the Kinde Polka Fest.

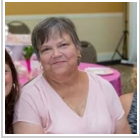
