little league through high school. He was seen in many gyms and athletic fields

throughout the area.

He dearly loved his home town and all the people in it. He volunteered his time and

talents to his church and his community. He had friends that he enjoyed breakfast, lunch

or dinner with or just a cup of coffee and sharing all the local "news". While he was shy

as a child and teen, he became very talkative to anyone and everyone as an adult. The

only people that were strangers to him were people he hadn't met yet. Once you met

him you were his friend.

Larry graduated from both Port Hope High School and St. Clair County Community

College. After college he worked for Thumb Farm Service which later became Star of

the West. Working there was a huge part of both his life and identity. His coworkers

were like another family to him. He loved his time there so much he was employed with

them from 1976 until his retirement in 2017.

After retirement he developed a love for travelling. His favorite way to see the country

was a guided tour where he only had to pay and let someone else worry about the

details.
