June 7, 1919 - October 17, 2004

Leo J. Geiger age 85, of Harbor Beach passed away on Sunday, October 17, 2004 at his home following a three-year battle with cancer, under the care of hospice.

Leo was born on June 7, 1919 at his residence of 85 years to the late Charles & Lena (Hessling) Geiger.

Father George Flanagan united Mr. Leo J. Geiger and Lucille Schroeder in marriage on October 4, 1941 at St. Anthony`s Catholic Church in Helena.
