



## Leonard Joseph Messing

July 26, 1913 - December 11, 2007

Leonard J. Messing age 94 of Harbor Beach passed away Tuesday, December 11, 2007 at his Sigel Township home with hospice care.

Born July 26, 1913 in Ruth, Michigan, he was the son of the late Henry and Helen (Tenbusch) Messing.

Leonard was a member of Our Lady of Lake Huron Catholic Church in Harbor Beach. and was a former Great Lakes sailor from 1930-1934 and worked on the assembly line of Ford and Chrysler when the lakes were frozen in the winter time. He purchased his farm in 1934. On June 22, 1935, Leonard and Theresa Romzck were united in marriage in St. Anthony's Catholic Church, Helena. Together they farmed in Sigel Township. Leonard was a card player, especially playing euchre with family and friends. He was a former board member of the Adams School in Sigel Township for several years.
