Leroy E. Schave, age 90 of Port Hope, passed away Tuesday, January 11, 2022 at McLaren Bay Region of Bay City.

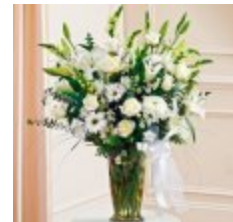
