



Lloyd K. Essenmacher

Lloyd K. Essenmacher, 81, of Harbor Beach passed away on Monday, March 09, 2009 peacefully at his home with family at his side while under the care of hospice.

He was born on November 23, 1927 in Harbor Beach to the late Joseph and Virginia (Warner) Essenmacher. Lloyd and Marilyn Booms were united in marriage on June 20, 1953 at St. Anthony's Catholic Church in Helena.

Lloyd was a Sergeant in the U.S. Army, serving as a paratrooper in the Eleventh Airborne Division at the end of World War II and in the occupation of Japan.
