LOIDE E. BAHR, age 90 of Unionville, passed away Sunday, June 30, 2019 at McLaren Bay Region Hospital.

She was born on March 11, 1929 in Hillman, to the late Herman and Emma (Krueger) Cordes. Loide and Rev. Albert Bahr would be united in marriage on June 26, 1949 at St. John Lutheran Church, in Hillman. Together Loide and Pastor Bahr served at many different Churches, impacting many lives. She enjoyed reading, music, gardening, genealogy, visiting with friends and family, especially her grandchildren, always looking for deer, and her passion was writing. Loide earned a Bachelors Degree from Central Michigan University at the age of 62. She published a book "Port Hope Remembers" and was currently working on another published book.

Loide is survived by her husband Rev.
