April 2, 1902 - October 31, 2004

Magdalene C. Roggenbuck age 102 of Harbor Beach, near Helena passed away Sunday, October 31, 2004 at her home in Sherman Township.

Born on April 2, 1902 in Sand Beach Township, she was the daughter of the late John and Mary (Bischer) Holdwick.

Magdalene attended Ferris Institute in Big Rapids, MI and taught in rural schools in Huron County for six years. On June 15, 1927, Magdalene and Henry Roggenbuck were united in marriage in St. Anthony's Church in Helena. She and her husband spent their married life on a farm in Sherman Township. Henry preceded her in death on March 4, 1978.
