Marie Cecilia Tenbusch, age 89 of Bad Axe, passed away to go home to our Heavenly Father after a long illness at Meadow Lane Assisted Living in Bad Axe, on Saturday, May 23, 2026. She was born on the family farm near Parisville on February 3, 1937, daughter of the late Edward and Bertha (Wrubel) Dekoski. She grew up on the family farm and attended the Grace Public and St. Mary Catholic grade schools in Parisville. She went on to graduate from the Ubly High School.

She married the love of her life Robert Tenbusch, on June 22, 1957 at St. Mary Catholic Church in Parisville. They shared much love and life in the 63 years of marriage working side by side along with their children on their farms near Verona and Rapson. Marie was very involved in supporting her husband and sons in their musical pursuits of leading a polka/dance band for many years. Her polish heritage and music was very important to her, and she enjoyed teaching countless people, both young and old to dance to polka music. A favorite activity was to listen to the weekend polka shows on the radio and television, and in her younger years attending as many polka dances and festivals as she could. them to music lessons and encouraging daily practice time.

Marie was a member of St. Hubert Catholic Church (St. Joseph Church) . Her faith was especially important to her as she faithfully participated at Mass each Sunday and during the week and had a special devotion to Our Lady of Fatima by praying the rosary every day, always remembering offering those many prayers for all who were in need of prayer. Another top priority was nurturing and encouraging her family to grow in their gift of faith. She was a member of the St. Mary Rosary Sodality, past member of the St. Mary and St. Joseph Choirs, St. Anne Mothers Study Club, Scripture Study group, and the Daughters of Isabella.

Baking and sharing her famous German Chocolate Cake and apple pie gave her great joy, as did cooking her tasty meatballs and holiday meals for the entire family. She had an immense love for her entire family and especially treasured time spent together with her sons, daughters and their families, as well as her siblings, friends and neighbors.
