MELVIN L. LONG, age 86, of Harbor Beach, passed away Tuesday, October 09, 2018 at Harbor Beach Community Hospital.

He was born on July 19, 1932 in Harbor Beach to the late Frederick & Lucy (Will) Long. Melvin served in the US Army from 1952-1954, serving during the Korean Conflict. He and Sally Hurren were united in marriage on January 19, 1957. She preceded him in death on October 22, 2011. Melvin retired from the City of Harbor Beach, in 1992 after 33 years of service.

Melvin was a member of the United Methodist Church of Harbor Beach, the AmVets Post 115 of Port Hope, and the Harbor Beach Gun Club. Melvin enjoyed wood crafting and fixing. He was an avid deer hunter, fisherman, and loved the Outdoors.
