RAYMOND E. MAZURE, age 87 of Harbor Beach, passed away Tuesday, August 14, 2018 at his home.

He was born on December 20, 1930 in Harbor Beach, to the late Frank and Alice (Buchkowski) Mazure. Ray served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. Ray and Barbara Booms were united in marriage on February 20, 1954 in St. Anthony's Church in Helena. She preceded him in death on August 20, 2005.

Ray was a member of Our Lady of Lake Huron Catholic Church. He enjoyed eating with his Al's Restaurant Family, enjoying his Coffee Club, riding his scooter, and trips around Harbor Beach monitoring the towns activity.
