ROBERT D. DUNCANSON, age 83 of Harbor Beach, passed away Tuesday, August 23, 2016, at Lake Orion Nursing and Rehab Center.

He was born on February 18, 1933 in Harbor Beach to the late Robert and Emily (Colhoun) Duncanson. He and Dorothy Frindt were united in marriage on June 15, 1963 in Harbor Beach. She preceded him in death on January 11, 2015.

Bob Served in the US Airforce. He worked on the family farm his whole life. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Harbor Beach, and the AmVets Post of Port Hope. Bob was an amateur Radio operator, liked to read, play cards, enjoyed water skiing, fishing, travelling, and was an all around handyman for everyone.
