Robert P. Romzek, age 68 of New Haven, passed away on November 30, 2008 after a long illness at Briarwood Manor in Flint. He was born in Mt. Clemens on December 20, 1940 to the late Lawrence and Theresa (Kociba) Romzek. He is survived by his sisters: Gloria Elkins and her husband Robert of Deland, FL, Maureen Fogel and her husband Gene of Canton MI, Barbara Romzek and her husband David Greenamyre of Lawrence, KS, Kathryn Shotwell and her husband Floyd of Shelby Township, and many nieces and nephews. Robert was preceded in death by his sister Marilyn Abraham, and brother Jerome Romzek. He served 21 years in the military with 2 in the Army and 19 years with the Coast Guard as a meteorologist, an instructor at the USCG Institute and was a Senior Chief Marine Science Technician. In service to his country, he visited the South Pole 7 times and the North Pole 13 times, receiving many commendations from the Arctic and Antarctic regions of his study. Military burial at sea took place off the shores of Harbor Beach on Sunday, June 7, 2009 under the direction of the Harbor Beach Coast Guard Station with B.M. Perrault officiating.
