Roger L. Lamb, age 67, of Harbor Beach passed away Sunday at Harbor Beach Community Hospital after a short battle with cancer.

Roger was born on March 24, 1937 in Harbor Beach to the late Joseph & Lois (Lockner) Lamb.

In 1955 Roger became a Merchant Marine after graduating from Harbor Beach High School. For 18 years he traveled to many ports of call in several different countries. After retiring from ISPAT (Formerly Inland Steel), He was employed at the Harbor Beach Marina. When Roger was not working, He could often be found doing yard work, sitting on his front porch reading the newspaper, or following the Harbor Beach Pirates football and basketball teams.
