Sandra Jean Reid, 67, formerly of Harbor Beach, passed away peacefully on January 7, 2017, at McLaren Bay Region after a long illness.

She was born September 29, 1949 at the Harbor Beach Community Hospital, to Bernard and Catherine (Downey) Shubitowski. She graduated from Our Lady of Lake Huron Catholic High School in 1967. She graduated from Saginaw Valley State University with a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work and then went on to receive her Master's Degree at Wayne State University.
