Stanley J. Sopczynski age 83 of Harbor Beach passed away Monday, May 22, 2006 at his home with hospice care.

Born in Erie, PA on August 2, 1922, he was the son of the late John and Annastacia (Cerwinski) Sopczynski.

Stan was a veteran of World War II serving in the European Theatre.
