



## Stanley Peruski

May 26, 1920 - July 20, 2013

Stanley E. Peruski, age 93 of Harbor Beach, passed away Saturday, July 20, 2013 at Autumnwood Nursing Center of Deckerville.

He was born on May 26, 1920 in Minden City, to the late Adam and Agnes (Pawlowski) Peruski.
