Terry Elroy Blanchard, 79 of Harbor Beach, passed away at his home on April 11, 2021. He was born on March 19, 1942 in Manistique, Michigan to Eirnel and Marie (Breathour) Blanchard. He graduated from Our Lady of Lake Huron Catholic High School in 1960. After graduation, he proudly served his country in the United States Coast Guard. He was honorably discharged in 1964.
