



## Theodore H. Lange

August 17, 1913 - April 24, 2004

THEODORE H. LANGE age 90 of Port Hope was called to his heavenly home on Saturday, April 24, 2004. He died while hospitalized at Beaumont Hospital in Troy, MI after a long illness.
