Thomas Michael Stacer, age 47, of Ruth, MI, passed away Saturday, December 7, 2019, at his home surrounded by family and under hospice care. Thomas was born on January 17, 1972, in Harbor Beach, MI, to Calvin and Judy (Wipping) Stacer. Tom and Michele (Early) were united in marriage on June 21, 2003, at St. Anthony's Catholic Church in Helena.

Tom graduated from Harbor Beach High School in 1990. He worked at Booms Construction for 29 years, and although he was the foreman, he believed in a hard day's work and was the first to arrive at a job site and the last to leave. Tom was hardworking, funny, thoughtful, and loyal. He will be forever remembered for his love for his wife, Michele, for his big smile, and the sound of his laughter.
