I looked up to this man, I loved this man, and he will forever be missed.

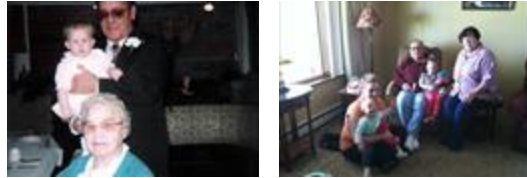
