W. Warren Pease, age 93, of Port Hope passed away Sunday, January 17, 2016 at Meadow Lane Assisted Living in Bad Axe, MI.

Warren was born on July 31, 1922 to the late Wallace and Mae (VanVoorhes) Pease of Port Hope. He was united in marriage to Betty Kinsman on February 21, 1948 in Port Hope. She preceded him in death on November 19, 2001.

Warren is a member of St John Lutheran Church of Port Hope. Warren served in the US Coast Guard Reserves during World War II. He is a retired engineer of U.S. Steel, sailing the Great Lakes for 32 years. After retirement, he was the Maintenance Engineer at Harbor Beach Community Hospital for 11 years and a volunteer first responder for the Eastern Huron Ambulance Service. Warren was a civic leader and supporter of the Port Hope community his entire life.

Surviving Warren is his son, Michael Pease of Warren, MI, a brother, Fred Pease and his wife Carolyn of Fort Gratiot, MI, a sister, Esther Hunter of Port Huron and Sister-in-Law, Mildred Pease of Port Hope. He was preceded in death by a sister, Lois Kaufman-Kerr and two brothers, Nelson "Hank" Pease and Robert Pease.

Funeral services will be Thursday, January 21st at 11am at St John Lutheran Church in Port Hope. Visitation for Warren will be Wednesday January 20,

2016 from 2-8pm at the Ramsey Funeral Home in Harbor Beach. Visitation on Thursday will be at the church beginning at 10am until the time of service at 11am. Burial will follow at Rock Falls Cemetery in Harbor Beach.
